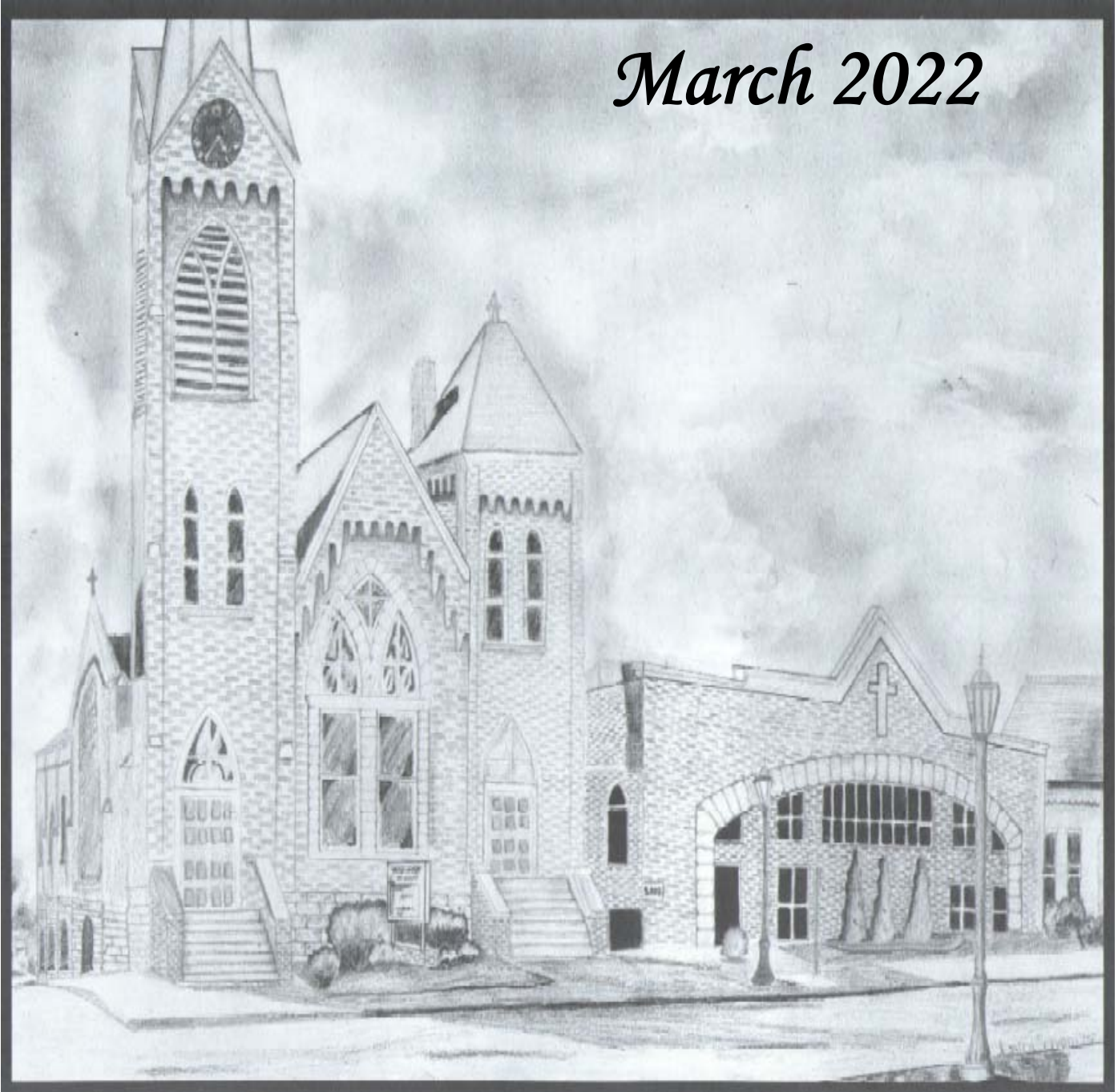

## Jesus to Me...

*“You will conceive and give birth to a son,  
and you are to call him Jesus.” Luke 1:31*

We all have different sides to our personalities. In various settings we are perceived in different ways. To those of you who have gotten to know my dad, your impression is mostly from visiting with him on Sundays at church. Some people know my dad as a boss at Fasco many years ago where he worked. When we run into classmates of his from high school, they call him Jackie, which is his given name. They know him from growing up with him. He has been involved with the Lions for years. My daughters know him as “Grandpa Jack” and my cousins call him “Uncle Jack.” The guys at Gier’s Bass Pro in Eldon know him as a dedicated and successful crappie fisherman. You could ask any of these groups of people to describe my dad and you would get many different descriptions and impressions.

If I was to ask you who Jesus is to you, what would you say? It might depend on the day or the situation you were going through. You might say, a little baby in a manger or beaten dying man on a cross. You might say the resurrected Lord, a great teacher, or conquering king. You might say he is Lord or a healer. In March and April we are going to look at many of the ways Jesus is described in the bible. The title of this series is “Jesus to me...” I think it will be an uplifting and insightful look at Jesus.

Also starting in March, we will begin our Lent season. Along with the statements of faith from our eight confirmands, we will look at seven of the miracles that took place when Jesus was on the cross. We will have various speakers including myself, Allan Mortenson, Pastor Frank Hensley, and some of our high school men and women speaking on this theme. It will be a great time of worship, scripture study, and encouragement. I look forward to sharing this season of Lent with all of you.

Each Sunday we continue to be blessed with guests. If you see someone you don't know on Sunday, I encourage you to introduce yourself and ask if they need anything. You might give them some materials from the Welcome Center like a pen, bookmark, or magnet along with a brochure about the church. I try to meet every guest either before or after church but sometimes I'm not able to get this done. I appreciate our greeters in the back and our elevator helpers for making guests feel welcome.

I love the words of this hymn, "Jesus, name above All Name." This is the first stanza:

"Jesus, name above all names, beautiful Savior, glorious Lord, Emmanuel, God is with us, blessed Redeemer, Living Word."

Each one of those names bring different images of Jesus to mind. I pray as we go through this sermon series, you'll see an image of Jesus that helps you through a difficult time and gives you the power and confidence to live a life of faith for him.

## **California United Church of Christ February 15, 2022 – Consistory Meeting Highlights**

The California UCC Consistory met for its regular monthly meeting February 15, 2022. Pastor Cobb opened the meeting with prayer.

The minutes of the January 2022 meeting, Treasurer's Report, Financial Secretary's Report, Stewardship Snapshot and Local Benevolence Report were reviewed and approved.

Reports and updates were given by committees and organizations: Evangelism, Historical and Memorial-nothing new to report.

Building and Grounds- expecting to replace doors to sanctuary in the first week of March. Nothing reported back on the streaming equipment. Awaiting quotes on the boiler, one quote returned at \$40,000 from H&D (10k more than last year). 4 additional quotes requested with no return. Worship committee discussed banners in Sanctuary – Confirmation Class ordering a new Easter Banner. Laura presented banners to purchase to have hung in the sanctuary each Sunday. Motion carried for the purchase of suggested banners and plan for the sanctuary. Stewardship committee reported success with Rock Solid Financial Planning workshop.

Brotherhood and Women's Guild continue with monthly meetings. Sunday school had a good meeting and continues to discuss ways to meet all our members.

Date for Cabinet Meeting set for March 27<sup>th</sup> 4pm-Each committee and organization should plan to meet ahead of time discuss what is planned for the new year and how it follows our church's mission. Plan to send a representative to report at the meeting.

An additional Money Counter has been found! Mary Bueker will start helping in that capacity. A Biblical Donation Library has been offered, consistory members are reviewing as consists of 2000 books including Bibles, serious studies, references, etc. More information to come.

After discussion regarding passing the offering plate. The group decided the current process is working well, the percentage of funds given via E-giving is stammering and we are exploring additional e-giving opportunities for guests. It is important to note the consistory no longer considers this a COVID restriction.

Renée, our awesome, dedicated office manager has announced her retirement effective July 29, 2022. The consistory will put together a job description for posting. We very much appreciate her time and dedication to our church with a lifelong commitment of service.

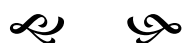

Our February benevolence is Grace Living. The Grace Living Center is a long-term transitional living center for homeless women with addictions. Their program is faith-based and firmly grounded in the belief that with Christ we can do anything. It teaches that thru trust in God's unconditional love and belief in the salvation that Christ freely gives us, we can overcome a life of addiction and failure.

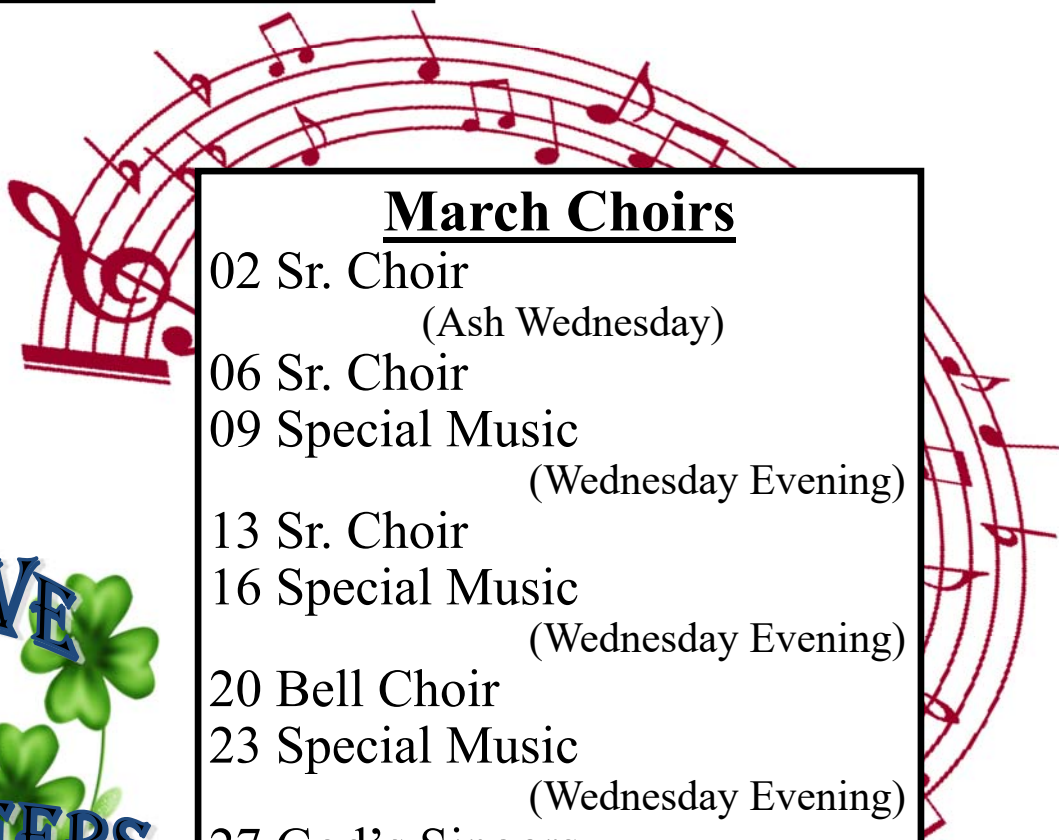
