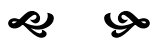


NEED HELP WITH EXTRA CHORES?
